Progress Report 5

Felicity is scheduled to be launched next Monday! (May 2nd). Barbara, the children and I will be on hand with champagne to ensure that things are done properly. After the launching Hinckleys will need the boat for about a week to finish fitting out and conducting their sea trials. I expect to be in Southwest Harbor beginning about the 9th of May to begin stowing gear and checking things out.

Torpey and I plan to go on a shakedown cruise to Nova Scotia from the 15th to the 22nd. We have a crew of four at the moment but if anyone would like to join us they are, of course, welcome.

Once we return from the shakedown Felicity will go back to Hinckleys for any necessary repairs and then I will begin stowing the supplies for the crossing and the final fitting out.

Dave Collins has dropped out and Pete Coggins is taking over his spot. For those of you who don't already know him Pete is a doctor at Mass. General was in the crew that sailed Bob Colvin's boat back from Bermuda in 1979. After Torpey (who simply said "yes") Pete holds the record for the shortest time to make up his mind that he wanted to come - about 30 seconds. Welcome aboard.

Nils has done a super job on planning the stores. His list is enclosed. If anyone has any suggestions or sees anything they just can't stand to eat let Nils know. We will be ordering most of the stores shortly. The selection of alcoholic beverages was rather arbitrary (Nils and I picked what we liked). If you have some other favorite tipple which you would like to have on board let Nils know.

My poll on survival suits came out in favor of having them. (You should never trust a secret ballot). Accordingly I have rented suits for all of us for the season. They cost \$125 apiece and I would appreciate it if you could reimburse me for this. While we are on the subject of safety I bought a Lirakis safety harness and am very impressed with it. It looks strong and is easy to get into and out of. If anyone is interested Goldberg's Marine has them for \$62. They come in four sizes:

Small (34-38)
Medium (39-41)
Large (42-45)
Extra Large (45-60)

Goldberg's address is 202 Market St., Philadelphia, PA 19106 and they take Mastercard and Visa.

Following is proposed list of stores for Felicity's Atlantic Crossing.

The list is based on the following cooking-eating strategy:

Breakfasts:

Will be done on a fix-your-own basis, with crew members free to combine on an ad-hoc basis in cooking pancakes, scrambled eggs, etc.

Lunch:

The cook for the day will be responsible for preparing lunch, which generally will consist of hot soup and sandwiches, with the option of cooking a complete hot meal available.

Dinner:

the cook for the day will be responsible for cooking dinner. Below is a list of the basic menus on which stocking was based. Obviously, the cook will be free to extemporize.

Washing dishes and pots:

will be the responsibility of the watch on duty at the conclusion of each meal. We will use paper plates as much as possible.

Basic dinner menus:

- Hamburgers with ad hoc vegetables -- 2 meals
- Steaks with ad hoc vegetables -- 2 meals
- Boneless chicken breasts with ad hoc vegetables -- 1 meal
- Roast beef with ad hoc vegetables -- 1+ meal
- (Fresh meat to be purchased in Boston and frozen to allow preservation on board for several days even if refrigeration should fail.)
